BEFORE USING Fax Forwarding Connector

Basic requirements and system requirements for Fax Forwarding Connector

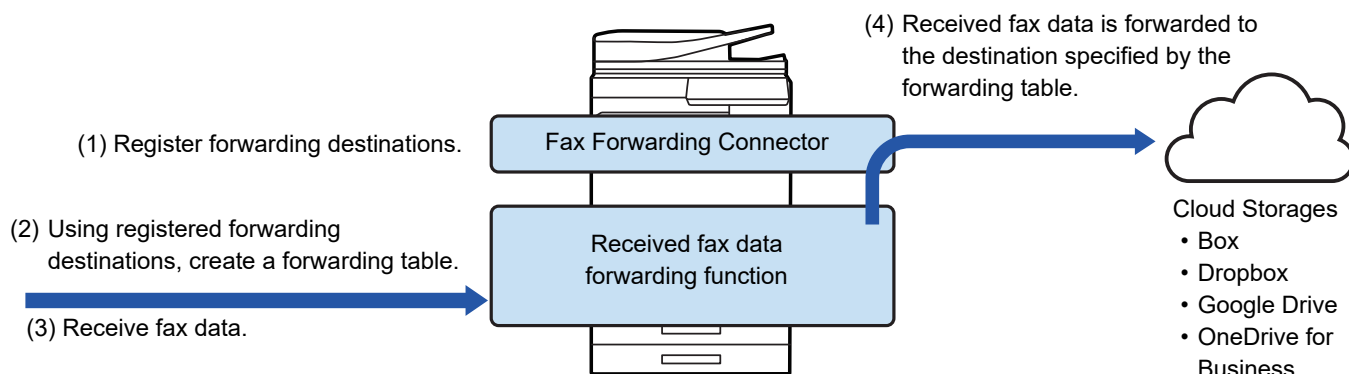
USING Fax Forwarding Connector

Perform the following setting procedure in order to use the Fax Forwarding function.

(1) Register forwarding destinations.

(2) Using registered forwarding destinations, create a forwarding table.

Conduct the step “(1) Register forwarding destinations” by using the Fax Forwarding Connector.



Register forwarding destinations

Tap the Fax Forwarding Connector ([Google Drive - Fax Forwarding], [OneDrive - Fax Forwarding], [Dropbox - Fax Forwarding], [Box - Fax Forwarding]) key on the Home screen.



- “XXXXXXXXXX-Fax Forwarding” denotes the name of the installed Fax Forwarding Connector.
- If you cannot find the Fax Forwarding Connector icon on the Home Screen, register the Fax Forwarding Connector to the Home Screen in the Home Screen Settings of the machine System Settings.

This application registers the Forward Destination for received fax data and sorting method.

When forwarding destinations are already registered:

Tap the [Add] key on the forwarding destination list screen.



A maximum of four destinations can be registered for a single Fax Forwarding Connector.

Perform the login operation according to the directions displayed on the cloud service login screen.

Select the forwarding file on the folder selection screen, then tap the [Next] key.

Select the desired sorting method on the sorting method selection screen, then tap the [Next] key.



If the selected sorting method includes “Sender,” adding a check mark in the “Change Sender’s Name to Contact’s Name in Address Book” check box changes the folder name of the “Sender Name” folder to the contact name registered in the address book.

Enter the name of the forwarding destination on the forwarding destination name input screen, then tap the [Register] key.

Registered forwarding destinations are shown on the forwarding destination list screen. Registered forwarding destinations can be edited or deleted.



To forward received fax data to a registered forwarding destination, it is necessary to choose the cloud service to use by selecting [Inbound Routing Settings] in the System Settings of the multifunction machine and using [Set (Cloud Services)] in [Table Registration].

For the detailed procedure, refer to the User's Manual of the multifunction machine.

Re-registering forwarding destination access privilege

If the cloud service access privilege has been lost, the process to forward data to the cloud service will not be executed. In that case, perform the login procedure again and re-register the access privilege.



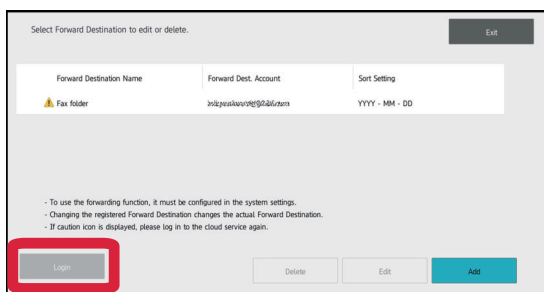
The forwarding destination that the cloud service access privilege has been lost is indicated by the  mark at the top.

Tap the Fax Forwarding Connector ([Google Drive - Fax Forwarding], [OneDrive - Fax Forwarding], [Dropbox - Fax Forwarding], [Box - Fax Forwarding]) key on the Home screen.

A forwarding destination list screen will be displayed.

Select the forwarding destination indicated by the  mark, then tap the [Login] key.

A cloud service login screen will appear.

Perform the login operation according to the directions displayed on the screen and tap the [Register] key on the forwarding destination information editing screen.

The privilege to access the forwarding destination will be re-registered.

Import/export of setting

The following describes how to export forwarding destination information registered in the Fax Forwarding Connector used by a multifunction machine for use with the Fax Forward Connector for another multifunction machine and how to import information exported from another machine.

Importing/exporting setting

In “Settings (administrator)”, [System Settings] → [Sharp OSA Settings] → [Embedded Application Settings], then choose the desired Fax Forwarding Connector and select [Export/Import].

Validating the imported forwarding destination information

After the setting is imported from another multifunction machine, be sure to perform the following operations.

1

Tap the Fax Forwarding Connector ([Google Drive - Fax Forwarding], [OneDrive - Fax Forwarding], [Dropbox - Fax Forwarding], [Box - Fax Forwarding]) key on the Home screen.

A forwarding destination list screen will be displayed.

Select a forwarding destination and tap the [Login] key.

A cloud service login screen will appear.

3

Perform the login operation according to the directions displayed on the screen and tap the [Register] key on the forwarding destination information editing screen.

The forward destination settings become valid in the multifunction machine into which the data was imported.
